To complete application enrollment, send a deposit of \$500 with this agreement. This is applied to tuition costs but may not be refunded at any time. Note: Tuition may be income tax deductible.

Please Read:

1. Once fully signed, this Enrollment Form shall constitute a binding and enforceable contract between the parties and is the full understanding of the parties hereto and no change, modification or waiver of any of the terms hereof shall be effective unless in writing and signed by both parties.
2. Cross Culture Exchange Corporation. (hereinafter referred to as "CCE"), its officers, directors, and employees shall not be responsible for clothing, mail, packages or personal possessions lost or damaged by fire, theft, laundry, malicious mischief or personal negligence.
3. Camper and Parent/Guardian hereby grant to CCE the right to use all videotape and photographs taken at the camp for publicity and advertising purposes without payment to Camper and/or Parent/Guardian.
4. Due to the seasonal nature of the camp, there is no refund or credit for any portion of the camping period not completed as a result of late arrival, early departure, dismissal for cause, disability or withdrawal for any other reason whatsoever. Camper and Parent/Guardian recognize that there is a risk that campers may not complete the camp session, and in what event, assume full loss of tuition.
5. Camper and Parent/Guardian agree to abide by CCE's rules and regulations, which are designed for the health and safety of the camp and its participants. CCE reserves the right to terminate any Camper's session if, in CCE's sole judgment, the conduct of the Camper and/or Parent/Guardian is not in the best interest of the camp. In the event that a Camper is dismissed from the camp, there will be no tuition refund. CCE reserves the right to search the personal property of each Camper, and each Camper and Parent/Guardian hereby consents to such search. Upon notification of dismissal, Parent/Guardian shall immediately arrange to pick up or transport the Camper, or CCE has the right to have the Camper travel, via public or private transportation, and it shall be the Parent/Guardian's responsibility to meet the Camper upon arrival. CCE is not responsible for Camper's traveling to and from the camp, or for acts done by Campers or other parents while off the camp's premises. CCE assumes no responsibility for acts committed by Campers which are in violation of CCE rules or local laws.
6. Camper and/or Parent/Guardian must provide CCE with all pertinent medical and behavioral information for which the Camper has been treated or is otherwise known. Failure to disclose, in the sole judgment of CCE, all relevant medical behavioral information will result in the termination of the Camper's session with no tuition refund. Camper and Parent/Guardian hereby authorize the staff of CCE to use its best judgment and act on their behalf in the best interest of the Camper in the event of any emergency requiring medical or dental attention. All physician fees, hospital fees, medicines and any other medical expense are the responsibility of parent/Guardian. All medications brought to camp must be turned in to the camp nurse. Prescription medication must be

contained in prescribed bottles; Campers who fail to take medication as directed may be terminated without the benefit of tuition refund.

7. Camper and Parent/Guardian understand and acknowledge that the activities at the camp may involve risks of bodily injury and/or property damage. Camper and Parent/Guardian also understand and acknowledge that injuries received may be compounded or increased by negligent rescue operations or the assistance of CCE and its agents. Camper and Parents/Guardian assume full responsibility for any risk of bodily injury, Death or property damage arising out of or related to Camper's participation in the CCE program, whether caused by the negligence of CCE or otherwise. Camper and Parent/Guardian release and discharge CCE, its officers, employees, agents, servants, and volunteers from all liability arising out of or in connection with Camper's participation in the CCE program. Liability means any and all claims, demands, loss, causes of action, suits, or judgments of any and every kind that occurs during or incidental to participation in the Camp. Camper and Parent/Guardian agree that this release and waiver of liability, assumption of risk and indemnity agreement extends to all acts of negligence by CCE.
8. Camper and Parent/Guardian agree to indemnify, defend, save and hold harmless CCE, its officers, Directors, shareholders, employees, and agents from and against and with respect to any and all claims, debts, demands, damages (including direct, consequential, incidental or other damages), judgments, awards, losses, liabilities, attorney's fees, costs and expenses of whatsoever kind or nature at any time arising out of or related, directly or indirectly, to Camper's participation in the CCE program, whether caused, contributed to, or claimed to be caused by or contributed by the active or passive negligence of CCE or any other person, unless same is caused by the sole negligence or willful misconduct of CCE or its employees, agents, servants, and volunteers. Camper and Parent/Guardian will on request and at their expense defend any action, suit or proceeding arising hereunder and shall reimburse and pay CCE for any loss cost, damage, or expense (including legal fees) suffered by it hereunder.
9. Any disputes, actions, arbitration, or other proceeding arising out of or related to which CCE or its agents is a party, shall be governed by California Law.
10. Camper and Parent/Guardian understand, acknowledge and agree that the obligations of CCE are only the obligations of the corporation and are not in any way personally guaranteed by its owners, directors, officers, managers, employees, agents, servants, or volunteers. Camper and Parent/Guardian hereby covenant that they will not under any circumstances sue or bring any legal action against or otherwise seek to hold the owners, directors, officers, managers, employees, agents, servants, or volunteers of CCE liable or responsible for the liable for any consequential and/ or punitive damages.
11. The terms of this contract shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto, their heirs, trustees, administrators, executors, successors and permitted assigns. The obligations under this contract are personal to Camper and Parent/Guardian and shall not be assigned.
